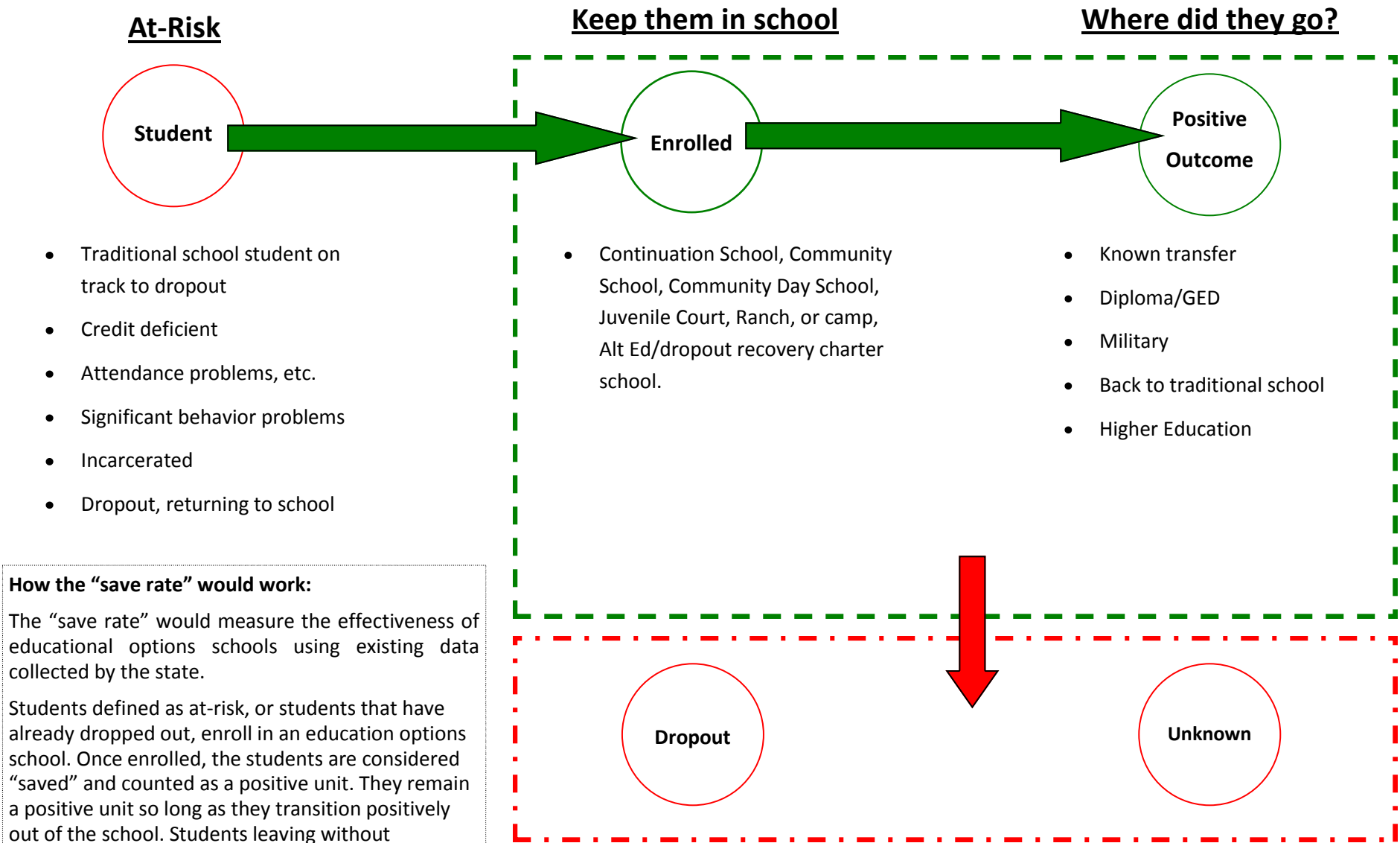


“Save Rate”



How the “save rate” would work:

The “save rate” would measure the effectiveness of educational options schools using existing data collected by the state.

Students defined as at-risk, or students that have already dropped out, enroll in an education options school. Once enrolled, the students are considered “saved” and counted as a positive unit. They remain a positive unit so long as they transition positively out of the school. Students leaving without completing are considered a dropout and would be counted against the school. By comparing the positive units to the negative units, a “save rate” is generated for each school.
