

ACSA has limited scholarship money available for members who want to attend job-specific academies.

### Who is eligible?

ACSA Regular Members who have a commitment to educational quality, student achievement and professional growth, and who can demonstrate a financial need.

### How do I apply?

Follow the procedures outlined below and in the Academy Scholarship Application on the next page.

### What is the deadline?

Applications and related materials should be submitted directly to State ACSA, to the attention of Jan Enzone by Monday, June 20, 2011. Recipients will be notified in writing by July 15, 2011.

### How are recipients chosen?

A Selection Committee comprised of a member from each academy job-alike committee will meet and review applications, essays, and financial needs of recipients. Names of finalists will be forwarded to the Board of Directors.

### Where does ACSA get the scholarship funds?

Donations from corporations and organizations which help support ACSA and its members.

### To apply for an ACSA Academy Scholarship please:

1. Fill out the registration form for the selected academy on pages 21-22 (only one application per member), but do not remit payment.
2. Complete the applicant/site/district profile on page 26.
3. Include an up-to-date resumé.
4. Complete an essay using the following criteria:
  - a. Discuss your present position and career goals and the ways that you provide leadership in your professional work setting and within the ACSA organization.
  - b. Discuss how attendance at this ACSA academy will enhance your contribution to education.
  - c. Describe your involvement with ACSA at the state, region and charter levels.
  - d. Provide a statement that demonstrates your financial need and efforts made to obtain funding through other sources.

### Eligibility

Priority will be considered for ACSA members who meet most of the following criteria:
