ACSA's job-specific academies provide a solid foundation in the application of leadership and management fundamentals for administrators who are new to advanced leadership positions or aspiring to the same. The academies are seen as the "fast-track" into a career as a superintendent, principal, business manager, curriculum and instruction or personnel administrator, special education/pupil services director, confidential employee or classified manager.

The academies are designed around the California Professional Standards for Educational Leaders (CPSEL) and the standards for the Commission on Teacher Credentialing's (CTC) Clear Administrative Services Credential (CASC).
